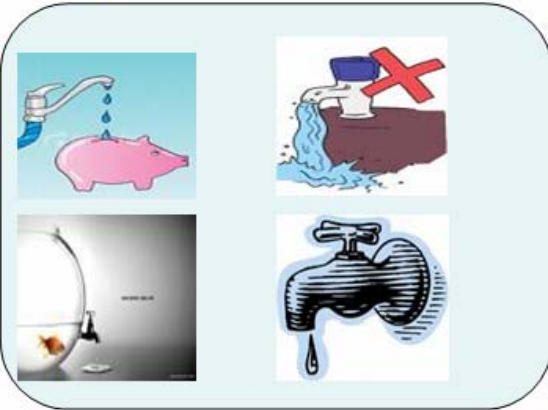




Save Water – Save Money



- Dripping one drop per second, can be wastage of 2,700 gallons of water per year.

Electrical energy



- Use electronic ballast for tube lights to save electrical energy.
- ENERGY STAR qualified refrigerator models to save 15% less energy.
- Close the door every time you take things out of the fridge and also check that it seals properly.

Save unit a day, keep power cut away

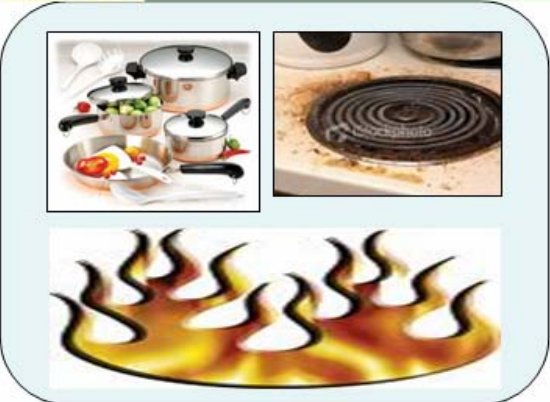
Safety

Energy saving
