Building Profile

The dream called Indian Spinal Injuries Center was commissioned in the year 1997-98 in the heart of South Delhi, merely 15 minutes drive from International Airport. ISIC covers a total area of 15,813 sq. mts. The Hospital is one of its kinds in Asia and is a tertiary level referral center for spinal diseases, orthopedic and joint replacement, neurosurgery, neurology, and urology. ISIC has now extended its wings to include all other medical specialties such as cardiology, rheumatology, gastroenterology, ophthalmology, pediatrics, psychiatry and psycho-sexual medicine to name a few.

ISIC is proud of its state-of-art rehabilitation center which provides the best of physiotherapy, hydrotherapy, psychotherapy, peer counseling occupational therapy, and aromatherapy to help patients accept and cope physically, psychologically, emotionally and socially with their illnesses.

ISIC is now also proud alma mater for DNB students in various specialties like orthopedics, anesthesia, family medicine, hospital administration and super specialties like spine surgery and rheumatology.

ISIC, though started with just 32 beds, now has a total of 134 hospital beds in various categories including ICU and ICCU. As part of its social responsibility, ISIC has earmarked 30 beds as free beds. It includes free consultation,

medication and surgeries. It also holds outreach camps on very frequent basis all over India with the sole aim of increasing public awareness about the importance of health.

Indian Spinal Injuries Centre is ISO 9001; 14001; OHSAS 18001 certified organization and has now set NABH accreditation as next target.

Energy Conservation Initiatives

Indian Spinal Injuries Centre understands that the need of hour is to save energy and has taken the following concrete steps towards the same. We are proud to mention that ISIC relies heavily on solar energy for various functions.

The changes that have been brought about in last few years towards energy conservation are as follows:

- ISIC is now reducing consumption of electrical energy by approximately 6.57% per year by installing Solar Water Heating System. This hot water is supplied in in-patient areas and also to the hydrotherapy pool. This pool forms a crucial part of the total rehabilitation plan of spinal injury patients.
- Another 3.77% of previously consumed electrical energy is being saved by switching over to 20Watt CFLs from Incandescent lamps and Florescent Tube Lights.

In summary, ISIC has taken proactive steps towards energy conservation in this year. Our success is exemplified by the fact that by using Solar Water heating System, ISIC is saving **60,000 SCM** gas energy per year.
